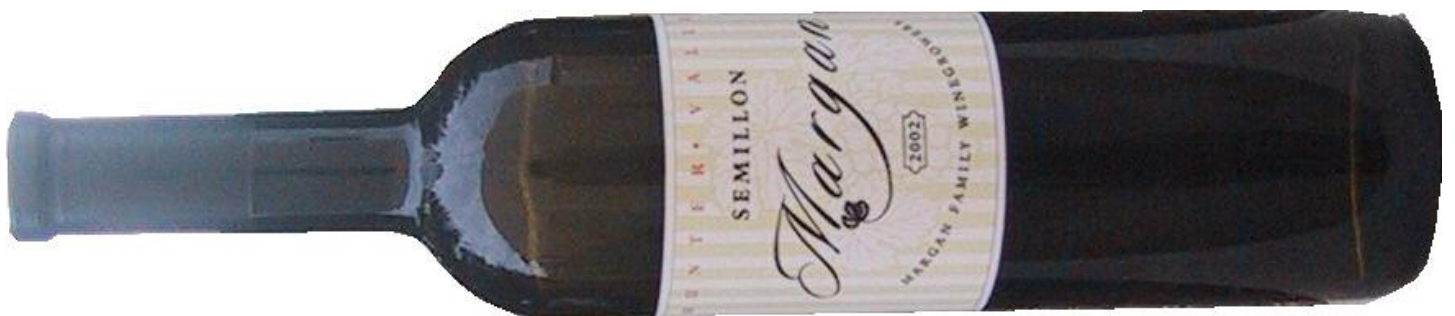


Margan Semillon 2002

“This modern winery, opened in 1997, is run by Andrew Margan, who completed 25 vintages at Tyrrell’s. He handcrafts 700 tonnes of fruit each harvest to make rich, full-bodied wines with a softness that makes them ready to drink young. Don’t cellar this wine; drink it. The warm, maritime climate gives the Hunter Valley region a long growing season without the arid heat of some Australian areas. This seems to create a more gentle wine. This family-run company strives to make wines that represent the taste and character of the individual grape variety. They do it well.”
