2006 Margan Semillon

91 POINTS

"Straw colored with green highlights, it offers an intense bouquet of mineral, citrus, spring flowers, and candle wax. Medium-bodied, with rich fruit flavors, lively acidity, and excellent length, this wine can be enjoyed now, but will add complexity with a few more years of bottle aging."

2006 Margan Verdelho

90 POINTS

"Medium straw-colored, it offers an enticing bouquet of mineral, spring flower garden, green apple, and lime. Medium-bodied, on the palate tropical flavors emerge. There is excellent concentration, lively acidity, and a long finish."

2007 Margan Shiraz Saignée (Rose)

89 POINTS

"Medium pink with a perfume of roses, spice box and strawberry. Dry and ripe on the palate, this medium-bodied Rose is savory and long in the finish."

2005 Margan Merlot

87 POINTS

"Dark ruby-colored, it offers spice box, cinnamon, and red currant aromatics. Supple and forward in the mouth, the tannins are soft and the flavors pleasant and easy-going."

2005 Margan Shiraz

89 POINTS

"Purple-colored, it has a savory nose of spice box, blackcurrant and blueberry. Medium-bodied and made in an elegant style, flavors of blueberry, muffin and licorice emerge on the palate to add complexity. There is enough concealed tannin to carry this Shiraz for several more years of development."

"An elegant dessert wine with a lovely perfume of peach, apricot and botrytis aromas. Nicely balanced by lively acidity and with excellent length, drink this tasty elixir with fruit tarts or cheesecake."
