95 Points - Margan White Label Limited Shiraz Mourvedre 2007

Great colour: The only such blend in the Hunter Valley I am aware of, slightly surprising given the suitability of the climate; a lovely wine, the two components seamlessly woven in synergistic support.

94 Points - Margan White Label Limited Release Shiraz 2007

Deep purple-red; great example of depth of the flavour that the Hunter Valley can achieve with restrained alcohol; plum, blackberry and mocha flavours to a plushy textured palate; excellent oak and tannin balance.

94 Points - Margan White Label Limited Cabernet Sauvignon 2007

Elegant medium-bodied wine with some slightly earthy regional overtones; blackcurrant fruit has juicy components alongside fine savoury tannins. Very good wine for the region.

94 Points - Margan Family Semillon 2008

Pale Colour: Pure lemon sherbet aromas; the palate is tightly knit with vibrant acidity and fruit, and just enough generosity for early drinking; the structure is there to reward patient cellaring.

93 Points - Margan White Label Limited Release Semillon 2007

Still at the dawn of its adult life, but showing the first hint of development; the bouquet is quiet, but palate has great drive and length, with mouthfilling lemon, herb and minerally flavours.

91 Points - Margan White Label Limited Release Barbera 2007

Strong crimson colour; fragrant and lively, offering plum, cherry and herbal flavours on the medium-bodied, well-balanced palate. A Margan specialty.
